

Ghost Lake Public Lands

Ghost Lake Village is home to more than 70 acres of public lands with the Summer Village of Ghost Lake municipal boundaries.

Recreational areas have been created in the center of the Summer Village with a golf course and playground and along the south edge of the Summer Village, with a multi sport court.

Public service areas have been created on lot 601 where the Community Services Building and storage building are situated and on the east side of the Summer Village with the waste management site (compost pile, burn pile and garbage bins) and the seasonal storage site.



The Council strives to maintain the remainder of the public lands as **natural areas** for all to enjoy nature at its best. Except where a low impact path has been created leading to the spring on the west side of the Village, **driving on public lands disturbs the environment and is prohibited**.

Residents are also fortunate to have **access to the lakeshore**. The Summer Village maintains a lease with TransAlta that provides residents use of the shoreline adjacent to the Summer Village for recreational purposes. This is the *only* area outside of the Summer Village of Ghost Lake's municipal boundaries that the Summer Village has received permission for residents to access. *Please note that the Summer Village does not have permission for residents to access any of the First Nation lands adjacent to the Summer Village.*

Autumn is an excellent time to enjoy the natural areas in the Summer Village for hiking, enjoying the magnificent fall colors and viewing migratory birds. Be aware of your surroundings at all times and be respectful of the land and the wildlife.
